



RIVER VALLEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE IS ON THE MOVE IN KEENE

River Valley Community College President Steven Budd is pleased to announce that the College will begin holding classes in its newly renovated Academic Center in the former Roosevelt School building at 438 Washington Street on Monday, October 25, 2010.

Since opening the Center on Marlboro Street in 2004, the College has seen a continual increase in enrollment and a need to provide expanded services and courses to students in the Monadnock region. The Washington Street location offers more classroom space, along with new computer lab, science lab and nursing lab facilities.

“It’s a very exciting time for our college community in the greater Keene area,” remarked President Budd. “We have a little more work to do in some parts of the building, but that will occur during Phase 2 of the building’s updating process in a couple years. In the meantime, students, faculty and staff will occupy the space beginning Monday, October 25th.”
