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REFUND / WITHDRAWAL POLICY **SPRING SEMESTER 2010**

REFUND POLICY (Credit Courses):

Students who officially withdraw from the college/institute or an individual course by the end of the eighth (8th) calendar day (**Tuesday, January 26**) of the semester will receive a 100% refund of tuition, less non-refundable fees. This policy applies to all semester length and alternative semester formats. Students in classes which begin after the designated start of the semester (e.g., a mid-semester start) will have 8 calendar days from the start of the class to withdraw for a full refund. Exception: Students in courses that meet for two weeks or less must drop by the end of the first day of the class in order to receive a 100% refund. All Federal Title IV funds (i.e. Pell, SEOG, and Perkins Loan) are prorated and refunded according to the Rules and regulations mandated by the U.S. Department of Education.

All refunds require that the student complete an official withdrawal/drop form.

WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSES (Credit Courses):

Students who drop a course or courses before or on the eighth (8th) calendar day (**Tuesday, January 26**) of the semester (or other prorated enrollment period) will be refunded 100%. (No refund after that time.)

Deadlines for Withdrawing from Courses (SPRING SEMESTER 2010) (NO REFUND):

(Completed and signed Drop/Withdrawal Form must be received in Registrar's Office. See pages 13 of the Student Handbook for course withdrawal policy.)

(Deadlines for courses starting or ending beyond the usual semester dates will be adjusted.)

Before you register, please read the following notice:

I understand that I must fulfill my financial obligation two weeks (January 5) before the first day of the semester or my registration will be voided and my classes deleted. I understand by registering for courses at RVCC, I am financially obligated for ALL costs related to the registered course(s). Upon a drop or withdrawal, I understand that I will be responsible for all charges as noted in the student catalog and handbook. I further understand that if I do not make payment in full, my account may be reported to the credit bureau and/or turned over to an outside collection agency. I also understand that I will be responsible for the costs of the outside collection agency, any legal fees, and any bounced check fees under RSA 6:11, which will add significant costs to my account balance.
