How To Prepare

There are a number of practice materials available to acclimate you to the style of questions you will find in the TEAS.

You need to register for the TEAS at
www.atitesting.com.

On the day of the test, remember the following:

- Arrive 15 minutes early to the testing site
- Bring 2 or more #2 pencils
- Schedule 4 hours to take the test
- Scratch paper will be provided by the testing center
- Do not bring calculators
- Basic 4 function calculator allowed and embedded within the online version of the exam
- Electronic devices (cell phone, tablets, MP3 players) are not allowed
