

Governor's STEM Scholarship Program

The Governor's Scholarship program provides 100% funding to New Hampshire 11th and 12 grade students for two STEM or STEM related courses per year taken at any CCSNH college. This includes courses in science, technology, engineering, or math. The funding will cover the tuition for courses taken through the Running Start, Bridge2College, or e-Start programs.



eStart is a dual credit program that affords NH high school students the opportunity to take 100% online college courses through the Community College System of New Hampshire (CCSNH), while earning both high school AND college credit simultaneously.

Earn College Credit in High School!

The Running Start program allows high school students to take RVCC courses for high school AND college credit while still in high school. Courses offered through the Running Start program are college courses taught at the high school by RVCC college credentialed high school faculty as part of the daily class schedule.



Bridge2College is a dual enrollment program that enables high school juniors, seniors, and home school students to take college classes at RVCC for 50% off our regular tuition. Bridge2 College students earn general education credits that are transferable to other two and four year colleges.
