Five-year average job placement rate within twelve months of graduation. (2015-2019)	This is the number of graduates who are employed in the radiologic sciences within twelve months of graduation compared to the number of graduates who are actively seeking employment.	From 2015-2019, approximately 37 graduates were seeking employment; 34 graduates obtained employment within 12 months of graduation. 6 out of 41 graduate were not actively seeking and 1 continue education	75%	34/37 = 92%
Five-year average program completion rate (2015-2019)	This is defined as the number of students who started the program divided by the number of students who completed the program	From 2015-2019, 52 students started the program, 41 students have graduated the program.	80%	41/52 = 79%
