### **The Career**

Occupational Therapy Assistants (OTAs) help people improve their ability to perform tasks in all aspects of daily living. They work with individuals who have conditions that are mentally, physically, developmentally, or emotionally disabling. They also help them to develop, recover, or maintain daily living and work skills. Occupational Therapy Assistants help clients not only to improve their basic motor functions and reasoning abilities, but also to compensate for permanent loss of function. Their goal is to help clients have independent, productive, and satisfying lives.

## The Program

The Occupational Therapy Assistant program is fully accredited by Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE) of the American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA). Each academic year, 16 new students are accepted to the OTA Program at RVCC. Within their studies at RVCC, students have the opportunity to extend their curriculum up to three years if they so choose.
