The Healthcare Applications Pre-Registered Nursing Certificate Program is designed to prepare students to apply to the Registered Nursing (RN) Program at RVCC. Through this program, students will complete one year of foundational college courses and prepare to transfer into further education.

In this program, students will take pre-requisite and co-requisite courses for RVCC's RN program, reducing their semester workload once in the RN program and providing them with essential healthcare skills. Additionally, students may take elective courses, allowing students to explore additional areas of interest.

Students in this program must achieve a "C" or higher in all courses to graduate.
