The Massage Therapy Certificate Program prepares graduates for rewarding careers as licensed massage therapists in private practice, hospitals, chiropractic offices, wellness centers, cruise ships, spas, resorts and fitness centers. Students enter the field with a broad background and the ability to work with a diverse group of clients and health care providers.

The Massage Therapy Certificate Program may be completed in as little as one year full-time or two years part-time. Classes run in the daytime, generally before 4pm. Graduates of the program enter the workforce community as trained professionals able to meet the needs of a diverse society.

This program prepares students for licensure in new Hampshire as well as most other states. The curriculum equips the student with the knowledge to manage a massage business or become employed in clinics, nursing homes, chiropractic offices along with fitness centers and spas, or hospitals.
