Physical Therapist Assistants, often called PTAs, work under the direction and supervision of physical therapists in a variety of healthcare settings. They help patients who are recovering from injuries and illnesses to regain movement and manage pain. The Physical Therapist Assistant Degree program also prepares students for the national PTA licensure examination.

The PTA program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE). http://www.capteonline.org. The PTA program combines classroom and laboratory work at the college with two full-time (8 weeks & 10 weeks) supervised clinical education experiences. Once matriculated into the PTA program, all courses must be completed within three (3) years, unless special permission had been obtained from the Program Director.

Graduates earn an Associate of Science Degree. Upon passing the national exam, they are eligible to obtain licensure in any state for practice as a PTA. Full-time and part-time job opportunities are widespread.
