After review of the requested interim report, the continuing accreditation status of the associate degree radiography program sponsored by River Valley Community College was considered at the March 27, 2026 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. The next site visit is tentatively scheduled for the Fourth Quarter of 2029.


The program is advised that its publications must accurately reflect the current goals and student learning outcomes assessed by the program.
